Speen Parish Council is the Data Controller under the Data Protection Act 2018 and will use the information you provide on this form to facilitate processing your Grant Aid Application and making payment for awarded grants.

The legal basis for processing this data is the necessity for carrying out a public task. We will keep your data for seven years following the receipt of your Grant Aid Application. Payment details will only be kept until payment for awarded grants has been completed.

We will not normally share your information with organisations without your consent. However, there may be certain circumstances where we would share without consent such as where we are required to do so by law, to safeguard public safety, and in risk of harm or emergency situations. Any information which is shared will only be shared on a need-to-know basis, with appropriate individuals. Only the minimum information for the intended purpose will be shared.

Individuals have a number of rights under data protection law, including the right to request their information. You also have a right to make a complaint about our handling of your personal data to the Information Commissioner's Office <https://ico.org.uk/>
