It was unanimously agreed to return comments of Objection to West Berkshire Council as the multiple applications received to the variation of conditions of this development are incredibly difficult to follow. SPC feel that until further information is received on why local housing associations feel they are unable to take on these units and evidence that the developer has exhausted all resources in trying to fulfil these planning obligations that we cannot support this application.

Suggested sites for this were within local businesses (pubs, golf course, fuel stations and shops as well as local schools and the Community Café with the newsletter also being shard to the website and Facebook page. SPC may also send communications out requesting volunteers to distribute through the doors of local households.

Councillors decided that content could include Community Café Update and local events from the church, local schools, football clubs and other community associations as well as advertising for local businesses and the hire of Speen Pavilion. The content would also include updates from SPC on community projects and local history information.

Cllr Worby will contact WBC to enquire n printing costs at their print room and Cler will speak to other local clerks to obtain other printing providers and current costs.



Once this information is obtained Clerk to include within budget for next financial year.

Printing costs will be obtained for both A4 sheet, front & back and 4-page A5 booklet in both B&W and Colour.

Cllr Worby will draft a template for the newsletter to be shared with councillors at the next full council meeting.
